Facilitation Process



- Identify Challenges
 - Create problem statements
- Select three challenges for “report back” using 10-4 voting process

Facilitation Process



- Identify Solutions/Recommendations
 - Create solution statements
- Select three solutions/recommendations for “report back” using 10-4 voting process

10-4 Voting



- Each person will receive 10 dots per discussion
- Vote on “top three” by placing dots next to problem & solution statements.
- Use all of your dots – up to 4 on any one problem or solution statement

Report Back



- Moderators synthesize “top three” from each break-out group and share this information with the general assembly.
 - Provide framework for publications.
 - Provide context for collaborations & action
